Australia's 2015 social security and welfare budget

= **6.3%**
added to the average cost of living

Serious and organised crime cost Australia

\$36 BILLION

in 2013-14.

= **\$1561**
from every man, woman and child in Australia

= **217 million**
baskets of groceries (at an average cost of \$167.45 per basket)

= **3 weeks pay** (average for the entire work force)
